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Project Title: Serving Educationally Disadvantaged Students: Expanding and Replicating the Scholarship Prep Model

Total Recommended Award Amount: \$12,000,000

Project Goals: Scholarship Prep Charter Schools (“SPCS”) is a Charter Management Organization operating 2 schools serving 753 children in Orange and San Diego Counties, within Southern California. The goals and expected outcomes of this project are to:

1. Expand and replicate to provide access to greater numbers of educationally disadvantaged students.
 - a. Increase student Enrollment to 3,550 students by Year 5
 - b. Expand grade levels served to TK-12th
2. Increase student academic achievement, especially for educationally disadvantaged subgroups.
 - a. Closure of Achievement Gap for all Subgroups of Students in Mathematics & English Arts (ELA) on the CAASPP by 5% each year
 - b. Increase reclassification rates for EL Students by 5% each year
3. Prepare students for college and career success.
 - a. 100% of HS students take SAT or ACT
 - b. 100% of HS students will be college ready, according to the University of California's A-G requirements
 - c. 100% of HS students will apply for scholarships
4. Maintain a positive, safe school climate to ensure high levels of student engagement.
 - a. Average Daily Attendance (ADA) attendance rate is 96% or higher
 - b. Annual Student Retention rate of 90% or higher
 - c. Annual suspension/expulsion rate will not exceed 4%
5. Maintain fiscal solvency and operate using CMO best practices.
 - a. SPCS will maintain a 8-10% budgetary reserve each year
 - b. Annual audits, conducted by State approved auditing firm, will not produce any issues

Meeting the Purpose of the CSP: SPCS will expand and replicate eight (8) high quality charter schools within the next five (5) years.
