

# FY 2020 TQP Absolute Priority

# ABSOLUTE PRIORITY (AP)

**AP: Partnership Grants for the Establishment  
of Effective Teaching Residency Programs  
(Residency Model)**

*Applicants **MUST** address this AP.*





# Absolute Priority (AP)

- Applicants should read the TQP NIA and TQP program statute for full AP language.
- Applicants **MUST** address ALL AP requirements or application will be deemed ineligible.
- Applicants **MUST** use the *Required TQP Absolute Priority Checklist* to document absolute priority requirements in the application.



# TQP Residency Model Highlights

- Residency models **must** establish a new or redesign existing teaching residency programs.
- Residency models **must** have a rigorous selection criteria for residents and mentor teachers.
- Residency models **must** offer a **one-year** Living Wage Stipend/Salary (LWS).
- Residency graduates **must** graduate with a Master's degree not later than 18 months after beginning the program and state licensure.
- Residency graduates **must** complete a 3-year service agreement with the partner high-need LEA, if not, LWS **must** be repaid.
- Residency models **must** provide at least a 2-year Induction Program.
- Residency models **must** provide training and support for teaching residents.




# One Academic Year Clinical Experience




# 12-Month Living Wage Stipend/Salary




# 18-Month Design for Master's Degree and State Licensure

# Required Absolute Priority Checklist

## REQUIRED TQP ABSOLUTE PRIORITY CHECKLIST

### **Effective Teaching Residency Programs (Teacher Residency Program)**

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Applicants must provide page number(s) for each requirement that has a space provided in the Page Number column to identify where each requirement is discussed in the application's project narrative or shown via a document or form included in the appendix. Some requirements are dependent on the design of the applicant's project and are listed "as applicable."

# FY 2020 TQP Competitive Preference Priorities

# COMPETITIVE PREFERENCE PRIORITY - CPP

**CPP 1: Spurring Investment in Qualified Opportunity Zones  
(0-3 points)**

**CPP 2: New Potential Grantee  
(0 or 3 points)**

Applicants **MAY** address either CPP.



# Competitive Preference Priorities (CPPs)

- Applicants should read the TQP NIA for full language of the two CPPs.
- The CPPs are **OPTIONAL**; applicants are not required to address these priorities.
- Applicants should clearly identify if they have addressed one or both CPPs and where the responses can be found in the application.
- The CPPs are worth up to an additional 6 points.

# COMPETITIVE PREFERENCE PRIORITY 1

SPURRING INVESTMENT IN QUALIFIED OPPORTUNITY ZONES (UP TO 3 PTS)

Spurring Investment in Qualified

Demonstrate that the proposed service areas overlaps with a QOZ by:  
(1) Provide the census tract number for the proposed service area; and  
(2) Describe how applicant will provide services in this area

# COMPETITIVE PREFERENCE PRIORITY 2

NEW POTENTIAL GRANTEE (0 OR 3 PTS)

New  
Potential  
Grantees

The Department encourages eligible partnerships that have not previously received grants under the TQP program to apply.

Possible  
Priority Areas

- Has never received a TQP grant; and
- Has never been a member of a group application (i.e., in a TQP eligible partnership) that has received a TQP grant.
