Project Description:

The *3RinSWTQP* project will provide a residency program in high-need LEAs for 75 future teachers in special education, and secondary mathematics and science. The project design brings a team of committed partners together to create a dynamic collaborative system in which university faculty provide subject-matter and pedagogical expertise, teacher mentors support and guide resident teachers, and program staff conduct professional development and ensure that activities reflect the diversity of the communities participating in the project.

Expected Outcomes: (1) Improved teacher preparation programs; (2) Improved district induction programs; (3) Increased teacher effectiveness; (4) Improved student achievement in math and science education; (5) Students with limited English proficiency (EL) and special needs receive improved instruction; and (6) Improved teacher retention rates (3-year)
