Association of Alaska School Boards (AK) will advance a systemic approach to family engagement through polices, programs, and activities in underserved communities. The continuum of family engagement trainings for local education agencies, state education agencies, school boards, and families will serve 59,000 students and their families, predominantly Alaska Native. The 14 LEAs and 200 schools, serve a high number of low income and special education students. In years 2-5, LEA-Family cohorts will choose from a menu of evidence-based strategies to build skills and capacity for family engagement in LEAs.
