

Campus Compact for New Hampshire (NH) in collaboration with Partners for Rural Impact propose the following activities—Statewide asset mapping; establishing regional sites in urban and rural locales; statewide training of parents and educators to include: Mapp’s Dual-Capacity Framework convenings, NNPS/Epstein’s types of family involvement convenings, training (differentiating at key cradle-to-career levels; face-to-face and online units developed); Parent Nation mobilization training, peer-to-peer leadership development, parents in service roles (VISTA, AmeriCorps); parent identification and amelioration of barriers for children; ongoing work with CBOs through events, collaboration; and evaluation of development, implementation. The proposed number of participants to be served include: 167,910 children and students as well as their families. The applicant proposes serving 21 school districts.
