

Mid-Atlantic Equity Consortium, Inc. (MAEC) (ME) activities are divided into a multi-tiered system of technical assistance – Universal, Targeted, and Systemic – to create and sustain an equitable and transformational family engagement statewide infrastructure. MAEC’s 25 short-term, mid-term, and long-term outcomes are aligned with GPRA measures and seek to increase the quality and quantity of high-impact, culturally responsive Family Engagement services, including increased SEA capacity to build a statewide infrastructure for systemic family engagement and increased LEAs/schools/Early Childhood Education provider capacity to support students’ social-emotional needs exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. Most resources will be targeted towards schools and communities comprising predominantly disadvantaged and underserved students, including 3,679 participants across 185 proposed sites.
