

Project Abstract

Georgetown County School District proposes to launch *Pathways to Success* with funding from the Magnet Schools Assistance Program. New whole-school magnet programs will be offered at five schools, serving a projected 2,077 students.

Pathways to Success includes four project level objectives: **Objective 1:** To implement high quality magnet programs that increase choice and promote diversity by reducing and preventing further minority group isolation in Carvers Bay schools. **Objective 2:** To develop and deliver innovative theme-based curriculum at each magnet school that strengthens student knowledge in academic subjects and provides all students enrolled in Carvers Bay schools the opportunity to improve academic achievement, meet challenging State academic standards, and achieve postsecondary success. **Objective 3:** To implement evidence-based interventions at each magnet school in the Carvers Bay attendance area through enhanced partner engagement that ensures all students have equitable access to high quality education and engaging learning environments. **Objective 4:** To increase the capacity of magnet school administrators and teachers to deliver an academically rigorous, theme-based curriculum that is sustainable.
