

Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District (LVJUSD) - MSAP Abstract Magnet

Schools: LVJUSD adopted a Voluntary Desegregation plan that will increase student achievement and lower minority group isolation (MGI) by: (1) Carrying out one new, evidence-based whole-school STEAM magnet school program at Marilyn Elementary School; and (2) Significantly revising one existing magnet school program, the Dual-Immersion (DI) Program (Spanish-English), at Junction K8 School. The grant will serve approximately 1,500 unique students over the five-year grant period at an average cost of \$6,702 per student. By the end of the grant period each school will have the following student capacity: 415 students at the Marilyn ES STEAM magnet grades TK-5, 610 students at the Junction K8 DI magnet grades TK-5, and 327 students at the Junction K8 non-DI middle school programming grades 6-8. **M**

Objectives and goals: **Objective 1:** To reduce MGI among Latinx students and socioeconomic isolation among low-income students at the proposed magnet schools and increase enrollment of Latinx students at one feeder school. **Objective 2:** To ensure that all students receive high-quality magnet curriculum units and courses that integrate the school's unique theme into core instruction and are aligned with state standards. **Objective 3:** To increase the percentage of all students and student subgroups who score at standard or above on the state assessments in ELA, math, and science. **Objective 4:** To provide professional development to school leaders and instructional staff across the magnet schools to build the school's capacity to improve curriculum, instruction, and magnet theme development and implementation. **Objective 5:** To provide all students with equitable access to high-quality education and engage family members.
