**Mundo Verde Bilingual Public Charter School's Address:**

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Mundo Verde Public Charter School is committed to strengthening student learning by growing the number of trained educators from diverse backgrounds that are prepared to execute on the highest quality bilingual education in public charter schools. A local educational agency (LEA) operating two campuses in Washington, DC, Mundo Verde Public Charter School is an Expeditionary Learning (EL) Education School whose curriculum is framed around the unifying themes of biliteracy and sustainability. The Instituto Mundo Verde's curriculum emphasizes:

- Language acquisition in English and Spanish;
- Hands-on, project-based interdisciplinary learning expeditions;
- Integration of sustainability-focused content and values;
- Character and social-emotional development; and
- Student-centered instruction to foster the success of each child.

Designed as a fellowship, Instituto supports a diverse educator workforce and professional growth to strengthen student learning. The program will have a direct and positive impact on the quality and quantity of bilingual teachers in charter schools by (1) recruiting high-quality candidates new to teaching, and (2) training these educators to have a direct and rapid impact on academic achievement and outcomes for students in charter LEAs.

**Outcomes:** The project's outcomes include an expanded and more diverse, community-based educator workforce that is prepared to work in bilingual programs and/or support English learners, and learning among English learners and other at-risk students in public charter schools is strengthened and achieves better results.
