Project Title: New Leaders National Aspiring Principals Fellowship

Project Description: The Fellowship is a principal preparation program with a national reach, focused on developing transformational leaders committed to equity and excellence in education through the cultivation of leadership concepts and competencies aligned to New Leaders' Transformational Leadership Framework TM and conceptual frameworks from Historically Black College and University (HBCU) partners. SEED will allow partners to design outreach, recruitment, admissions, and selection processes to maximize equity and access, implement an evidence-based program, support program alumni to drive improved student and teacher outcomes, and validate the impact of the model through a rigorous evaluation conducted by the American Institutes for Research that meets What Works Clearinghouse standards with reservations.

Project Expected Outcomes: The Fellowship will increase the number of diverse school leaders and improve student outcomes, especially for underserved student groups. At least 75% of applicants will identify as aspiring leaders of color and scale the number of aspiring leaders served through the Fellowship during the grant period. At least 75% of program starters will complete the program, with no discrepancy in results by race or gender, and at least 90% of participants will express satisfaction with the program and alumni support.
