Grade levels served: Grades 3-5

Definition of high-need students: Students who are typically underrepresented in social and emotional learning (SEL) programs, including students of color, English Language Learners, and/or economically disadvantaged.

Project description and activities: The proposed Project will compare implementation of an SEL program, Harmony SEL ("Harmony Standard" condition) with a model that combines the SEL program with a taxonomy of academic–SEL integration ("Harmony Integration" condition). The Project will pilot the Harmony Integration professional learning and tools with nine schools. The Project will then randomly assign an additional 40 schools to Harmony Integration or Standard. Project objectives and expected outcomes: Project partners expect the following high-level outcomes with the Harmony Integration condition: improved (a) educator capacity, efficacy, and SEL and equity competencies to integrate SEL into academic instruction, (b) implementation quality of Harmony, and (c) use of more interactive, culturally-responsive instructional practices, leading to (d) improved classroom climate, and (e) a variety of student outcomes, as compared to the "Harmony Standard" condition.

Project Innovation: The innovation in this Project is an integrative taxonomy to build localized educator capacity, providing a needed exemplar for others to use.
