Greetings grantees,

The Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 (FFATA) is a Federal reporting requirement included in the program assurances section of each grant award notice (see your GAN Attachment 9 and [2 CFR Part 170](#)). The Office of State and Grantee Relations (SGR) endeavors to ensure that subaward data is accurately reported. As the data submitted through the [FFATA Subaward Reporting System](#) (FSRS) is displayed in the [Education Stabilization Transparency Portal](#), the public relies on this information. We understand that many of you are actively working to resolve discrepancies; however, we know there are still many grants currently overallocated or majorly underreported in FSRS.

To support States' efforts to meet this reporting requirement, SGR, in partnership with the Office of Finance and Operations Grants Management Policy Division, will be hosting a **FFATA Reporting Webinar and Forum on Thursday, January 26<sup>th</sup> from 1:00pm to 3:00pm EST**. During the webinar, we will provide an overview of FFATA reporting requirements, common reporting challenges, and frequently asked questions. We strongly encourage at least one individual from each State who is responsible for the State's FFATA reporting to attend. Advance registration is required and the webinar will be recorded.
