ABOUT

The FSCS grant program provides support for the **planning, implementation, and operation** of full-service community schools that improve the coordination, integration, accessibility, and effectiveness of **services for children and families**, particularly for children attending high-poverty schools.

WHAT IS MY ROLE?

Nonprofit organizations (small and large) play crucial, multi-faceted roles in their communities. The FSCS grant has a **natural integration with the goals, programs, and initiatives currently being undertaken by many nonprofits.**

Nonprofits are **eligible to apply** as a lead member in a consortium with one or more local educational agencies (LEA) or the Bureau of Indian Education (BIE).

EXAMPLE PROJECTS



A nonprofit is partnering with the Puerto Rico Department of Education to provide student, family, and community services to close gaps in education, health, and workforce development in impoverished neighborhoods.



A local nonprofit is leading a consortium to provide tiered wraparound services, extended learning opportunities, family engagement, and collaborative leadership programming at three public schools in the Tulsa Public Schools District.
