Oklahoma Public School Resource Center Charter Schools Program Grant

Since 2017, the Oklahoma Public School Resource Center (OPSRC) has been a recipient of a Charter Schools Program (CSP) State Entities (SE) Grant. Over the past years, OPSRC achieved their 2017 CSP grant objectives by: (1) increasing the number of high-quality charter schools in the state, with an emphasis on those serving educationally disadvantaged students; (2) improving student outcomes in Oklahoma charter schools, especially for educationally disadvantaged students; and (3) disseminated best practices.

OPSRC's objective for the 2023 Grants to State Entities project are:

Objective 1: Increase the number of high-quality charter schools in the state, with an emphasis on those serving educationally disadvantaged students. This will be executed by awarding five \$2 million subgrants annually for five years, for a total of 25 subgrants to new, expanding, or replicating charter schools in our state.

Objective 2: Strengthen the quality of Oklahoma's charter school operation and authorization. OPSRC will offer a robust technical assistance in three key focus areas: quality charter schools, quality practices, and quality authorizing.

This project will aim to award 25 subgrants to new, expanding or replicating charter schools and serve more than 7,500 students across the state of Oklahoma.
