Opening of Helix Legal Academy

Helix Community Schools (Helix) is a homegrown network of innovative, career-focused public schools located in Baton Rouge and seeks funding to support the recent opening of Helix Legal Academy (HLA or the Legal Academy), to serve grades 6-8, providing students with early exposure to the legal industry. HLA launched in the Fall of 2021 with a sixth-grade class with the plan to add one grade per year, reaching a full 6-8 middle school by the 2023-2024 school year.

HLA is a unique educational institution that combines a legal focus with STEAM education for students in grades 6 through 8. Entering its third year of operation, HLA is still within the crucial early stages of operation. This grant project aims to provide the necessary resources for its continued expansion and to further support the Academy's growth and sustainability. Specifically, the grant funding will be utilized to launch the 8th grade, completing the middle school offering and solidifying the Legal Academy as a comprehensive 6th-8th grade institution.
