Reporting Updates

GEER Year 3 (FY22) APR data correction period: The GEER Year 3 APR data correction period will close on Thursday, 9/7/23 at 8pm ET. This will be the last opportunity this year for GEER grantees to make corrections or updates to previously reported GEER Year 3 APR data. If your State received an email with potential data quality concerns identified by the Department, your State is required to review the data for accuracy, make updates, and resubmit the data if needed.

FFATA Subaward Reporting Accuracy Requirement – Grantees should continue to review program subawards in [FSRS](#) and demonstrate efforts to ensure accurate monthly subaward reporting by:

- Confirming FFATA subaward data for each grant displays accurately in [USASpending.gov](#)
- Providing an explanation of subaward reporting to their SGR program officer for any grant that displays a *Percent of Prime Award Obligated Amounts* under 90% (See the *Sub-Awards* tab in the *Award History* section of the *USASpending Award Profile* for each grant). Examples of acceptable explanations include:
 - Manner of grant implementation (subawards under \$30,000 or contracts determined to not justify a subrecipient relationship)
 - Technical challenges with FSRS (active FSD ticket/incident numbers must be shared with SGR)
- Correcting subaward reporting of any grant that displays a *Percent of Prime Award Obligated Amounts* over 100% (overallocated) in [USASpending.gov](#).
- Sharing any Federal Service Desk (FSD) ticket numbers and a description of the reported issues with their SGR program officer. If you do not receive a response from the FSD within three business days, SGR can escalate your issue to GSA. Questions? Deadlines and Announcements

ESSER Grantee Biannual Review: During October and November, SGR will conduct its second Biannual Review of grantees for 2023. This review will focus on each CARES, CRRSA, and ARP ESSER grantee's fiscal and programmatic oversight of its local education agencies and other subrecipients. Grantees will also be able to identify technical assistance needs and share practices that may be used during future technical assistance activities. Program officers will review the self-assessment submitted by each grantee and schedule reviews during the next monthly check-in meeting.

Maintenance of Equity (MOEquity) Update: On 8/31/23, all ARP ESSER grantees received a G5 communication that provides a status update on the implementation of the maintenance of equity requirements. As the Department prepares to finalize FY 2022 MOEquity compliance determinations, begin monitoring activities, and shift to implementation of FY 2023 requirements, States that have not yet demonstrated compliance with FY 2022 requirements should immediately contact their State program officer at State.name.oese@ed.gov to develop a plan to meet these requirements before enforcement actions begin in October 2023.

Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Data Now Available: Final FY 2022 and Interim FY 2023 Maintenance of Effort data for all States has been published and can be viewed in the [ESF Transparency Portal](#).

CRRSA Obligation Deadline and Extensions: CRRSA ESSER, GEER, and EANS funds must be obligated by 9/30/23. The Department has released an updated CRRSA Liquidation Extension Request template for grantees to utilize if an extended liquidation period is needed by the State or its subgrantees. Grantees may submit requests as soon as data are available and are encouraged to reach out to their State mailbox with any questions related to completion of a liquidation extension request.
