Summary Statement of Project: Seven rural Alaska school districts and the Alaska Council of School Administrators have constructed the *Raising the Bar for Rural Alaskan Educators (RTB AK)* partnership. Districts differ greatly in geography but what they share in common is:

- involving teachers in educational leadership
- refining evaluation systems and tying evaluation to professional development, and,
- exploring performance-based incentives for all staff.
