## Mastery Charter High School - S374A230022 Recommended Three-year Funding Amount: \$10,149,620.00

Mastery Charter Schools (Mastery) is a consortium of 16 LEAs with 1,800 staff serving 14,000 K-12 students in 24 high-need schools located in Philadelphia, PA and Camden, NJ. Mastery proposes a TSL grant project to address both Absolute Priorities, Competitive Preference Priority 1: Promoting Equity in Student Access to Educational Resources and Opportunities, and Competitive Preference Priority 2: Supporting a Diverse Educator Workforce and Professional Growth to Strengthen Student Learning. The three-year project will enhance the capacity of Mastery's Human Capital Management System through five project components: 1) Redesign Performance Management Systems; 2) Cultivate Internal Leadership Talent; 3) Strengthen New Teacher Induction; 4) Expand Teacher Pipeline Initiatives; and 5) Refresh Communications to support Talent outcomes. The project's objectives are to Increase Student Achievement; Improve Educator Retention Outcomes; and Demonstrate Annual Improvement on GPRA Measures.
