

**Ohio Department of Education (OH) (S371C190007) \$2,700,000** proposes to amplify projects in the Comprehensive Literacy State Development (CLSD) grant. The supplemental funds will align with and complement Future Forward Ohio, which encompasses the state's strategic priorities for using federal funds to help students recover from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, with a focus on students who experienced the greatest disruptions to learning. Moreover, the success of the Comprehensive Literacy State Development (CLSD) grant and the implementation of newly passed Dyslexia Support Laws have significantly increased statewide engagement in the identification of high-quality instructional materials, as well as evidence-based practices grounded in the science of reading. Post-pandemic achievement data continue to demonstrate the need for explicit guidance. Succinctly, supplemental funds would allow the Ohio Department of Education to support eighteen additional subgrants, and to scale assistance to existing sub-grantees. Funds will be distributed in Year 4.
