Sent 4/5/24 FFATA Reporting Updates: Grantees received information about reporting and verifying their FFATA reporting data in the FSRS system. Grantees are asked to verify that their FFATA reporting for each CARES Act and CRRSA Act program is accurate and complete by Friday, May 18, 2024, and for each ARP Act program by November 15, 2024. Sent 3/22/24 Recording and Reporting Federal Interest: Grantees received information regarding how to record and report the Federal interest when Federal funds have been spent to improve facilities. While most Department grant programs prohibit using Federal funds for construction activities, facilities improvements may be allowable projects under certain programs that were authorized to assist educational entities in responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, including ESSER, GEER, and reverted EANS programs. Uniform Guidance Update: On 4/4/24, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) published revised guidance to Federal agencies on administering and managing Federal awards in Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). **Link:** Reducing Burden in the Administration of Federal Financial Assistance

ARP ESSER State Plan Amendments: Any State considering making changes to its planned uses of ARP ESSER funds and has not submitted a request to amend its approved ARP ESSER State plan should do so as soon as possible. A State must seek an amendment if it plans to implement different or additional evidence-based interventions than those currently described in Sections D.1, D.2, or D.3 of its ARP ESSER State plan. States are not required to submit amendments for section D.4. For more information see the Department's 9/19/22 communication to Chief State School Officers.

Cybersecurity Preparedness for K-12 Schools and Institutions of Higher Learning: The Department has been made aware that some SEAs and LEAs may be vulnerable to fraud and cybersecurity threats involving their ESSER, GEER, and EANS programs. The <u>Readiness and Emergency Management for Schools (REMS) Technical Assistance (TA) Center</u> has resources available for SEAs and LEAs to ensure they are well prepared to address cybersecurity in their emergency management planning efforts and manage a potential cybersecurity incident.
